

## AQA history: specification overview

<b>Advanced Subsidiary 5041</b>	Module 1: AS European/World History	<b>one</b> compulsory 3-part source-based question <b>plus one</b> of <b>two</b> 3-part questions focussing on historical interpretation, on the chosen option from Alternatives A to L.	
	Module 2: AS British History	<b>one</b> compulsory 3-part source-based question <b>plus one</b> of <b>two</b> 3-part questions focussing on historical explanation, on the chosen option from Alternatives M to U.	
	Module 3: AS Course Essays	<b>two</b> course essays of 1000 words each, based on any 2 of the topics chosen for study within the Alternatives chosen for Modules 1 and 2.	
<b>Advanced award 6041</b>	Module 4: A2 European/World History	<b>one</b> compulsory 2-part source-based question, <b>plus one</b> of <b>three</b> synoptic essay questions focussing on historical explanation and judgement, on the chosen option from Alternatives A to L: this may be the <i>same</i> alternative chosen for AS Module 1, or different.	
	Module 5: A2 British History	<b>one</b> compulsory 2-part source-based question, <b>plus one</b> of <b>six</b> synoptic essay questions focussing on historical interpretations and perspectives, on the chosen option from Alternatives M to U: this may be the <i>same</i> alternative chosen for AS Module 2, or different.	
	Module 6: A2 Independent Investigations	6PS – coursework: personal study of approx 3000 words on any of the options chosen, or any other.	6W – written paper.
